Foaling Service 2022

Foaling your mare can be a worrying time, but you can be reassured that when she is with the Minster Equine Clinic she is in very experienced hands. Minster Equine clinic offers a comprehensive foaling service at our purpose built clinic where your mare will be monitored 24 hours daily. An experienced veterinary surgeon will always be present to assist your mare during foaling.

Charges

- Foaling fee £400.00
- Livery (mare) £16.00 per day
- Livery (mare and foal) £25.00 per day

We advise that a mare should be brought to us 2-4 weeks before her foaling date and that she stays for 2 weeks after the foal has arrived. The foaling fee does not include any treatment beyond what is considered a 'routine' foaling - please see page 2 for details of treatments that are included.

Clients bringing their horse for foaling are entitled to an extra 10% discount on our A.I schemes within 12 months of foaling.

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Mares that come to the clinic on livery for foaling will be turned out in individual paddocks during the day and stabled overnight. They are under observation by our team 24 hours a day. The facilities for foaling and neonatal care at our clinic include:

- Dedicated foaling boxes with heat lamps
- CCTV cameras to allow for round the clock monitoring
- On-site accommodation for our team with windows overlooking the foaling stables
- Individual paddock turnout and/or stable livery

The following **is** included in the foaling fee:

- Ultrasonography per rectum to evaluate foal position/presentation
- A full veterinary examination of both mare and foal post foaling
- A Fleet enema to help prevent meconium impactions
- Disinfection of umbilicus of foal
- IgG test at 24 hours old
- Caslick's repair if required post foaling.

The following is **not** included in the foaling fee:

- Transport costs to Rainbow Equine Hospital if surgical intervention is required
- Surgical repair of post foaling injuries
- Caesarean section or other surgery
- Treatment for retained afterbirth
- Plasma transfusions administered to foals with low IgG estimation
- Foal milk / colostrum
- Vaccinations e.g. 'flu / tet
- Treatment of neonatal illness or abnormalities post foaling
- Treatment of post foaling complications in the mare.

Our livery fee **includes**:

- Mucking out and paddock maintenance
- Grooming
- Hay or Haylage
- Straw bedding
- Stud nuts and chaff 2 x daily
- Worm egg count on arrival.

Our livery fee does **not include**:

- Farriery
- Feed or supplements beyond stud nuts and chaff
- Deworming products.



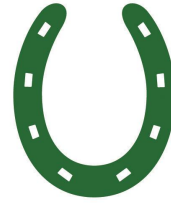
